Catholic Relief Services' Professional Post-Graduate Fellowship Program is designed to offer career opportunities for students interested in international development. Since its inception in 1984, CRS has placed more than 150 interns in overseas postings, and more than half have continued with CRS after their first one-year assignment. Fellows assist in the administration of projects in agriculture, community development, micro-enterprise development, health care, and counterpart agency strengthening.

All participants must be second year graduating degree candidates, with outstanding academic studies, have relevant professional backgrounds, and a high level of language acquisition either in French, Spanish or Portuguese.

In 1998, three additional students were offered postings in: Honduras (Deborah Georges-MPA), Liberia (Michael Christopher-MPA), and Kenya (William Godnick-IPS), but turned them down due to other opportunities.
